

## **Malta Internet Governance Forum Activity Report – 2014**

Below is an outline of the activities that took place in 2014

1. The Malta Communications Authority as chair of the Malta Internet Governance Forum attended all the High Level Internet Governance (HLIG) Meetings in Brussels which are chaired by the European Commission. These meetings were held in February 18<sup>th</sup>, June 16<sup>th</sup>, September 30<sup>th</sup> and December 2<sup>nd</sup>. The main topics that were discussed during the HLIG were:
  - a. ICANN/WEF initiative on IG
  - b. ITU Plenipotentiary meeting
  - c. EuroDIG
    - i. EuroDIG is a Pan-European dialogue on Internet governance based on an open platform for informal and inclusive discussion and exchange on public policy issues related to Internet Governance (IG) between stakeholders from all over Europe.
  - d. Outcome of Net Mundial
    - i. Net Mundial is a Global Multistakeholder Meeting on the Future of Internet Governance
  - e. Internet Engineering Task Force (IETF)
    - i. IETF produces Internet relevant technical documents
  - f. WSIS+10 preparations
    - i. The objective of WSIS + 10 was to review the progress made in the implementation of the WSIS outcomes under the mandates of participating agencies, took stock of developments in the last 10 years based on reports of WSIS stakeholders, including those submitted by countries, action line facilitators, and other stakeholders. The event reviewed the WSIS Outcomes related to the WSIS Action Lines and agreed a vision on how to proceed beyond 2015.
2. The Malta Internet Governance Forum delivered lectures at the Malta College of Arts, Science and Technology and University of Malta focussing on Internet Governance principles, issues and challenges.
3. The Malta Internet Governance Forum participated (remotely) in the IGF in Istanbul, Turkey on 2-5 September 2014.
