3 parallel work streams

- WSI: Mapping of cybersecurity agreements (continuation of last year's work and deeper dive into the drivers of cyber norms).
- WS2: Testing norms concepts against Internet events.
- WS3: Outreach and cooperation with other IG(F) initiatives.

Call for volunteers
