
IGF 2022 Timeline (Draft)1

1. Announcement of the MAG for 2022: 14 December 2021

2. IGF 2022 Community Call for Inputs: Taking Stock of IGF 2021: 14 December 2021 - 20 January 2022

All IGF stakeholders are invited to submit inputs to the IGF Secretariat related to the <u>following questions</u>. All inputs will be posted on the IGF website. MAG Members should periodically review these comments.

3. Call for Thematic Inputs for IGF 2022: 14 January - 14 February 2022

All IGF stakeholders are invited to submit inputs to the IGF Secretariat related to the following questions. All inputs will be posted on the IGF website and will be analysed to help define the IGF 2022 thematic focus MAG Members should periodically review these comments.

4. First IGF 2022 Open Consultations and MAG Meeting: 23 - 25 February 2022

First MAG Meeting held virtually.

Draft agenda points:

- Strategic discussion on implementation of the Secretary-General's Our Common Agenda and its Digital Compact
- Discussion on IGF 2022 main thematic tracks

5. Launch of IGF Intersessional Work - 1 March 2022

Setting thematic focus for BPFs /major policy initiatives (e.g. policy networks) and MAG working groups. DCs and NRIs are ongoing.

6. IGF 2022 Call for Session Proposals 22 April – 10 June 2022

All stakeholders were invited to submit proposals to hold workshops at the forthcoming IGF, as well as other session types: town halls, open forums, networking sessions, lightning talks, individual sessions by IGF Dynamic Coalitions (DCs), collaborative sessions by National, Regional and Youth Initiatives (NRIs), proposals for 'preevents' on Day 0.

7. IGF 2022 Call for Village Booths: 20 June – 31 July 2022

During the annual IGF meeting, interested stakeholders can display or distribute relevant information about their IGF-related activities at the IGF Village. The booths are non-commercial in nature, free of charge, and allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, respecting a balance of stakeholder and regional diversity. Booths are of limited availability.

8. Evaluation of Workshops and Other Session Proposals: 14 - 29 June 2022

- The MAG will evaluate all workshop proposals on the basis of pre-determined criteria.

9. Second IGF 2022 Open Consultations and Face-to-Face MAG Meeting: 6- 8 July 2022

Second 3-day MAG Meeting to be at the UN office at Geneva, Switzerland.

10.IGF 2022 Call for Remote Hubs: 20 July - 20 September 2022

Invitation to all stakeholders interested in organizing a remote hub. Hubs are local meetings that take place in parallel with the IGF. People can watch the webcast of IGF sessions together and send interventions (via text, audio or video) that can be answered by panellists in IGF.

11. Drafting of IGF 2022 Schedule and IGF Village plan: July - August 2022

Undertaken by IGF Secretariat in consultation with MAG; takes into account all agreed-on themes, possible tracks and session types. .

12. Publicising of Bilateral Meeting Request System: <u>20 July – 15 October</u> <u>2022</u>

An online system maintained by the IGF Secretariat, based on demand/availability of rooms.

13. Open Registration for IGF 2022: 15 August – 2 December 2022

Online registration for onsite and remote participants through IGF website/UN accreditation system with live/public participants list.

14. Third IGF 2022 Open Consultations and MAG Meeting: 21 - 23 September 2022

- Third 3-day MAG Meeting to be at the UN office at Geneva, Switzerland. MAG will carry out review of the overall programme.
