

**IGF 2025 MAG Meeting IV**

**1. Updates from the IGF 2025 Host Country (HC)**

- The HC provided suggestions on Day-0 and High-Level sessions to the IGF Secretariat. The session proposals will be ready for next week's meeting to allow for IGF main session preparations.
- An exhibition manual for exhibitors will be prepared. A total of 80 booths can be allocated in the IGF Village.

**2. Updates from the Secretariat**

- Participants of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Open Consultations and MAG meeting should [register](#) for the Second Open Consultation and MAG meeting taking place from 14 to 16 April 2025 in Geneva and online. A practical information note will be sent out to the MAG.
- So far, 226 registrations for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Open Consultations and MAG meeting received.

- The High-Level invitation letters for IGF 2025 have been sent out
- 3,200 workshop evaluations completed (80% completion rate) by the MAG
- 2,317 registrations for the annual IGF 2025 received.

**3. Status of the IGF 2025 Workshop Evaluation Process**

- The valuation process enters the second phase: group discussions will finalize the workshop selections
- MAG members will be asked to follow the traffic light system: workshops marked in green will be selected; workshops marked in yellow are to be discussed in more detail; workshops marked in red will be rejected.
- It was clarified that MAG members can be invited to speak in workshops but not in main sessions

**4. Updates from the IGF MAG Working Groups**

- The WG on Strategy set up 6 subgroups with following objectives:
  - WSIS+20 submission - completed and submitted in MAG name

- UN agency dialogue on the implementation of paragraphs 68-71 of the Global Digital Compact
- Draft a paper on the IGF Mission
- São Paulo guidelines: multistakeholder implementation webinars
- Government engagement: coordinate with host country plans
- UNGA statement: high-level multi-stakeholder statement for WSIS+20
- The WG on Youth Engagement did not provide an update.
- The WG on Multilingualism called for volunteers to translate MAG meeting notes into Spanish, French, Arabic and Russian. Any other languages are also welcome.

#### **5. Updates from the IGF Intersessional Work: Policy Networks, Best Practice Forums and Dynamic Coalitions**

- The PN on Artificial Intelligence is currently planning to align with the GDC and WSIS+20 and seeks to be represented at other major, global events, such as the G7 or the AI Summit.
- The PN on Internet Fragmentation waits for a consultant to be onboarded. The network plans on collaborating on the São Paulo guidelines.
- The PN on Meaningful Access plans on engaging with the ITU and other programmes, such as the ones of the European Union.
- The Dynamic Coalitions held another successful webinar with over 180+ registrations and 99 online participants.
