1. Updates from the Secretariat

- Currently 3333 registration requests and more to be expected.

2. Update on IGF workshops

- Currently, 49 workshops have been approved and confirmed by organizers to take place in Norway.
- The workshop duration was reduced from 90 to 75 minutes.
- Another 8 additional workshops are waitlisted to be added to the programme.
