1. Updates from the Secretariat

- Over 5000 registrations received with over 100 Members of Parliament and parliamentary staff
- The bilateral meeting room booking platform was launched this week. IGF participants can book up to 10 meeting room slots.

 - June 26 (Day 3): MAG - UN Under-Secretary-General meeting from 9:00 to 10:00 (local time, CEST) (TBC)

3. Finalization of the IGF 2025 Main Sessions

Main Session 1: [New Technologies and Human Rights Impact](#)

- The title and the session description have been finalized, together with three (3) policy questions
- The organizers will identify an African speaker from a small or medium sized enterprise (SME).
- They will also create a video including SME perspectives on human rights.

Main Session 2: [Governance of Artificial Intelligence](#)

- The session description is about to be finalized.
- The speakers have been selected and organizers will now reach out to gauge their interest and availability.

Main Session 3: [The impact of the IGF on the future of the Internet](#)

- Organizers will agree on the final title via the mailing list.
- They will slightly adjust the third policy question and finalize the list of speakers as well, inviting two representatives from her stakeholder group.

Actions

4. Updates from MAG working groups and IGF intersessional work

Working Group on Strategy:

- The MAG working group (WG) on Strategy plans the WSIS+20 high-level event session taking place in the second week of July (7 to 11 July) in Geneva.
- MAG members were encouraged to join next week's MAG WG on Strategy meeting.

Working Group on Youth Engagement:

- The WG will now match mentors with mentees as soon as the list of applicants is sent to them by the IGF Secretariat.

Working Group on Multilingualism:

- The WG suggested to identify 1 or 2 key documents that could be translated by the group on a voluntary basis into the 6 UN official languages for broader dissemination
- The group could coordinate with the WG on Strategy on potential key documents

Policy Network on Meaningful Access (PNMA):

- Two (2) speakers have been confirmed (from UNESCO and from Brazil). The network intends to reach out to an indigenous language expert, as well.

Policy Network on Artificial Intelligence (PNAI):

- PNAI published a call for input, which is open until 30 June.
- For their main session, they need to identify a government representative from Africa.
- The next webinar is scheduled for 3 June.

Policy Network on Internet Fragmentation (PNIF):

- The Network continues focusing on tracking fragmentation efforts.
- The next PNIF call is scheduled on 11 June at 12:30 CEST.
