

**IGF MAG Meeting XIV**  
**Action items & next steps**

**2 March 2026 | 11:00 UTC | Online**

**1. Updates from the Secretariat**

- The deadline for the call for [thematic input](#) and for [intersessional work proposals](#) has been extended to 8 March.
- Interested participants can [register](#) until 20 March for the [regional Parliamentary Summit](#) taking place on 24 March at the Uruguayan Chamber of Deputies and online.
- The IGF Secretariat will collaborate with the AI committee of the Judicial Council of Buenos Aires on 26 March on training magistrates and judicial officials.
- The IGF will hold a session during Geneva Cyber week (4-8 May) on Securing Internet Access during times of conflict; last year's focus of the IGF Best Practice Forum (BPF) on Cybersecurity.
- The IGF Secretariat closed the survey about the IGF website improvements, and the revamp will take place later this year.
- The first Open Consultation and MAG meeting is planned to take place mid-May. The location of the IGF 2026 will soon be confirmed, with expected dates in the second or third week of December.

**2. Draft Document on Suggested Improvements of MAG Working Modalities**

- Based on the Secretariat's [consolidation of survey results](#), a small ad-hoc working group was tasked by the MAG to develop an [advisory document](#) on suggested improvements to MAG working modalities.
- The MAG was asked to prioritize suggested improvements for the working group to develop a more focused and straightforward advisory document. The working group will not incorporate new suggestions made by the MAG 2025.
- The advisory document will serve as an input for the upcoming Expert Group Meeting and for the IGF 2026 MAG. Changes to MAG working modalities will not all be implemented in 2026 but will also be reflected in future cycles.

➔ **The ad-hoc MAG working group will meet to finalize the advisory document, before sharing it with the MAG ahead of the next virtual MAG meeting.**

**3. Updates on IGF Dynamic Coalitions (DCs)**

- DCs reiterated their readiness to provide substantive input and serve as a resource hub to MAG discussions in the lead-up to the agenda-setting.
- Two DC webinars were held last week on Postquantum Cryptography and on Digital Health. Another webinar is planned to take place in April on social media age verification.
- DCs might submit Policy Network or Best Practice Forum proposals for the IGF 2026 MAG's consideration.
- DCs have been submitting their annual reports by the end of March. DCs that do not demonstrate any activity will be archived (unless valid justification is provided).

→ The MAG is invited to follow DCs work and take part in upcoming DC webinars.

#### 4. Any Other Business

- Co-facilitators of the 2025 BPF on Cybersecurity are currently drafting a proposal to report on their work at [RightsCon](#) taking place in May 2026 in Lusaka, Zambia. The proposal will focus on creating a multistakeholder mechanism that responds to Internet access disruption in the context of conflict and crisis. They further consider submitting a Policy Network proposal for 2026.

→ The next virtual MAG meeting will take place on 23 March at 11:00 UTC.

→ The IGF community is invited to develop session proposals for the upcoming WSIS Forum, AI For Good Summit and Global Dialogue on AI Governance.
