# ANNOTATED AGENDA FOR MAG MEMBERS - 2nd IGF2020 Open Consultation and MAG Meeting, 15 to 19 June 2020

#### I. Context and meeting modalities

The second IGF 2020 Open Consultation and MAG Meeting will take place virtually over a five-day period from 15 to 19 June 2020. To facilitate an effective meeting, and to make it as easy as possible for MAG members to participate, the Secretariat and the Chair propose the following modalities:

- Meeting will take place over 5 days using Zoom features such as breakout group rooms and polls
- The Open Consultation will have French/English interpretation available
- All meeting plenaries will be captioned in English.
- Statements or briefings will be pre-recorded and made available on the IGF's YouTube account prior to the meeting
- Pre-meeting preparatory work will facilitate virtual decisionmaking

- Breakout group methodology and process will be pre-agreed before the meeting and facilitators and rapporteurs briefed
- There will be two types of breakout groups: Synchronous groups integrated into plenary timeslots and asynchronous breakout groups that will take place in different time-slots that are convenient for participants. These asynchronous breakout groups can take place at any time between the plenary from which they emerge, and the plenary they have to report back to.

### II. Milestones to be achieved by the MAG before the meeting

- Workshop evaluation process done in accordance with <u>General</u> <u>Guidance</u> of the MAG Working Group on Workshop Evaluation Process.
- Review of workshops with a high degree of variance in scoring, and decision on whether any warrant further discussion.
- Consensus on which workshops proposals can be eliminated on the basis of overall poor quality. Flag lower scoring workshops that are still in the pool that could add to programme cohesion for further discussion. Produce final ranking of workshops per thematic track clustered into Green, Yellow and Red "baskets".

- Identify possible sub-themes (where appropriate or desired) and assessment of extent to which high-scoring proposals cover the theme in each thematic track.
- At the discretion of each group, update the thematic narrative based on insights gained from the scoring by 10 June.
- Initiate discussion on main sessions (e.g. whether we want one for each track and workshop proposals you feel would be better as main sessions). What other topics could be the focus of main sessions? Keep in mind main sessions already under development (NRIs and "business models").
