




## Objectives and Mission of the South School on Internet Governance



After organizing the school, government created a specific area to follow up and participate in the Internet Governance ecosystem.

In some countries it was the trigger for organing national dialogues or national IG fórums, ISOC chapters.

Many fellows are selected for other fellowship programs: ICANN, ISOC, IETF, regional IGFs, etc.
