DENIC eG input to the IGF stocktaking consultation

DENIC appreciates the opportunity to participate in the stocktaking process for the 13th IGF and would like to offer the following suggestions.

- Dialogue benefits from both diversity in perspective as well as diversity in opinion. Therefore, we would encourage the MAG to **cluster proposals** around a smaller number of high level issues and to invite session proposers to **jointly prepare sessions**. This would help participants by limiting potential scheduling conflicts in the overall program as well as prevent fragmentation of the discussion sphere.
- In addition, we would like to suggest the MAG be even more vigilant about assigning sessions to "ready-mix" proposals.
- In general, while panels should have their place, we would encourage **more** interaction, both among the prepared participants as well as the wider range of attendees.
- With an ever increasing complexity and the successful growth of the meeting, there is enough "terra incognita" for everybody to explore. Assigning selected time and easily accessible space to **introductory or overview sessions**, repeated during the week and highly interactive, would foster the dialogue across stakeholder groups.
