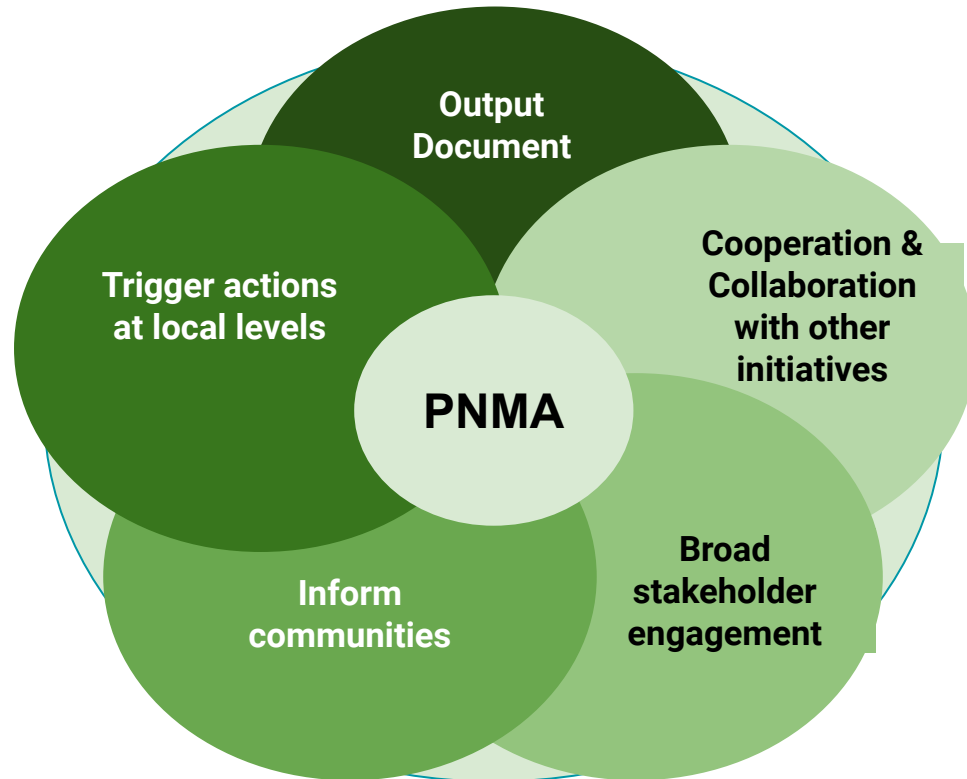


Statement of Purpose
