## But first... some stats from the Queer in AI demographic survey!

**Demographic survey:** comprehensive survey to *identify issues* within queer communities and *shape the future programs* of Queer in AI (take the survey at <u>queerinai.org!</u>)

#### Demographics of survey respondents:

- 30% **non-cis** folks
- 21.5% BIPOC folks

Note: **cis** refers to when gender identity corresponds to sex assigned at birth

- 10% mentioned **disabilities**
- 50% **graduate** students
- 20% have changed their name or plan to do so

#### Some more stats

- 85% reported lack of role models
- 80% reported lack of community
- 31% felt their mental health was lowest within the last year

### Even more stats! (ratings on a 1-5 scale)

- 3.4 rating on how comfortable queer folks feel at conferences
- 4.6 rating on how welcome queer folks feel at Queer in Al events
- 3.8 rating on satisfaction with **gender forms by cis folks**
- 2.6 rating on satisfaction with gender forms by non-cis folks
- < 20% of conferences had pronoun tags</li>

### Omg, more stats?! (ratings on a 1-5 scale)

- 90% non-cis reported that they would prefer only indicating pronouns, and not gender
- Non-cis folks reported a lot of cases regarding
  microaggressions, especially with pronouns and gender
- 2.8 rating on name change policy satisfaction
- 3.5 rating on deadnames not being cited

TikTok admits restricting some LGBT hashtags

TikTok has acknowledged that it restricts LGBT-related hashtags in some countries as part of its "localised" approach to moderation.

A **report by the Australian Strategic Policy Institute** (ASPI) think-tank said many LGBT hashtags were "shadow-banned" in Bosnia, Jordan and Russia.

A shadow ban limits the discovery of content without indicating that a particular hashtag is on a ban list.
