NRIs and COVID-19 (10 min)

- COVID-19 pandemic impacted the NRIs meetings: meetings a) postponed or b) meetings hosted remotely.
- All meetings scheduled by June 2020 reported to be postponed for later in the year.
- First time some of the NRIs meeting will be hosted **remotely**:

✓ *EuroDIG*: 10-12 June (initially hosted in Trieste, Italy)

- ✓ <u>LACIGF</u>: 3-7 August (initially hosted in Santiago, Chile)
- ✓ <u>APrIGF</u>: postponed from 26-29 May to 27-30 September (initially hosted in Kathmandu, Nepal)

Impact of COVID-19 Pandemic on IGF

Impact on IGF 2020 processes

- The Host Country, UNDESA/ IGF Secretariat continue to monitor the situation.
- Current situation indicates high probability of hosting the <u>2nd Open</u> <u>Consultations and MAG meeting</u> through online participation platforms (*initially scheduled to be hosted Geneva, Switzerland from16-18 June in*).
- The planning of the <u>15th annual IGF meeting</u> continues with the objective for the meeting to be hosted onsite in Katowice from 2 to 6 November.

- International contest for youth: MY INTERNET OF THE FUTURE 3 categories: essay, poster, movie. Awards: monetary.
