

IGF 2020 VILLAGE

- IGF 2020 Village to be set up as a virtual fair (through capacity of the IGF website or if necessary and possible through 3rd part service of virtual fairs organization).
- 70 booths to feature the Village: https://www.intgovforum.org/multilingual/village-booths-2020
- The IGF website to contain a map of the Village space with e-booth pins
- Each e-booth is clickable and leads to individual page that contains:
 - About section
 - *IG* activities
 - How to engage?
 - Write to e-booth organizer?
 - Schedule live consultations with e-booth organizers. Mark preferred time in the calendar (each e-booth organizer will offer several consultation appointments for the community to choose from).

IGF Secretariat will host the IGF 2020 Info Desk in the virtual IGF Village area through which participants can contact the Host.
